In The Classroom

- ❖ In **math workshop**, we will begin to learn about mixed numbers and improper fractions and that both are different ways to write fractions greater than 1. Students will practice identifying and labeling models as well as drawing models to represent a given mixed number or improper fraction. They will also learn how to convert mixed numbers into improper fractions and vice versa.
- ❖ In reading workshop, we will continue to work small groups using reciprocal teaching. Students will take turns applying predicting, questioning, clarifying, and summarizing skills while reading a differentiated news article. We will also be reading Chapters 4-6 in Mrs. Frisby and the Rats of NIMH. Please note that students may be asked to respond to critical questions about the read aloud instead of their regular reading responses for homework on certain days.
- ❖ In writing workshop, students are on their way to publishing their second persuasive essay on whether or not students should be allowed to bring lunch from home. They will focus on making sure they cite text evidence (giving credit to the source) and write to a more general audience. To wrap up this writing unit, they will also start the final performance task later in the week.
