In The Classroom

- ❖ In **math workshop**, students will review the midline assessment that was given last week (i.e., working on complete explanations and checking that their answers were reasonable). They will then move into learning the partial quotients method of division using 1-digit and 2-digit divisors.
- ❖ In reading workshop, students will continue working with nonfiction text features in order to understand how text features help them to comprehend a text at a deeper level. They will then work on identifying the main idea of a passage as well as the main idea of each paragraph in a passage. This idea will also help them to organize their upcoming persuasive writing pieces in a more supported manner.
- ❖ In writing workshop, students will continue to extend their quick jots into longer paragraphs. They will also be introduced to the format of a debate and use two different passages on a particular topic to form an opinion. Students will then use that information to participate in a mock debate, making sure to have valid reasons and/or examples to support their stance.
