In The Classroom

- In math workshop, students will learn division with regrouping (a method that is very similar to the standard algorithm) to solve problems with 4-digit numbers by 1- or 2-digit divisors. We will then review the concepts that were previously learned for Friday's Unit Test.
- In reading workshop, students will continue working with nonfiction text. They will learn about different types of media and the importance of using multiple sources. Students will then practice gathering facts, taking notes, and summarizing the important information from nonfiction videos and passages.
- In writing workshop, students will begin to jot down their thoughts about whether or not homework should be banned. They will also learn about different strategies for planning their writing (e.g., thinking about the reasons and examples they already have, researching for additional support for their stance).
