In The Classroom

- ❖ In math workshop, we will work on decomposing fractions and identifying data (fractions) on a line plot. We will also spend some time reviewing specific word problems that I noticed students having difficulties with, such as finding a fraction of whole set. At the end of the week, the summative performance task will be given. I am very happy that students have improved in their explanations and models, as shown in the formative performance task that was given last week!
- In reading workshop, we will continue to work in small groups using reciprocal teaching. Students will take turns applying predicting, questioning, clarifying, and summarizing skills while reading a differentiated news article. We will also be reading Chapters 11-12 in Mrs. Frisby and the Rats of NIMH as a class. In addition to guided reading and read aloud, we will spend certain reading workshops doing close reading on specific events that led up to the American Revolution to supplement the writing unit. For this week, we will focus on the French Indian War!
- In writing workshop, students have finalized their research questions and the three subtopics in which they will attempt to address that question. We will spend this week researching and taking notes for their informational article. I will also bring the students into the Computer Lab for online research. As mentioned in the notice that was sent home last Friday, please allow some time for your child to go to the library for additional resources so that they can use them during this week.
